

Dear Dr. Tewfik:

As I promised at lunch today, I am writing to suggest a plan of procedure on your proposed book.

The principal thing is for you to prepare at your earliest convenience a sample chapter, a table of contents, and an estimate of the length of the book, that is, the number of words approximately, and the approximate number of illustrations. The sample chapter need not be the first chapter of the book, and of course it need not be in final form. If you can conveniently let us have this material before you sail, then so much the better; but this is not necessary by any means. We do not want you to hurry, and it will be quite alright if you send it to us from Beirut.

When I receive this material, I shall go over it carefully with Mr. Norton and my other colleagues, and we shall be in a position to make a final decision about the publication of the book. If this decision is favorable, we shall draw up a contract and send it to you. According to our usual terms your royalties would be 10% of the list price of the book, on the first five thousand copies sold, and 15% thereafter. The list price will depend on the length of the manuscript and the number of illustrations, and will, I should think, be between

three and five dollars. The contract will also provide for the possibility of an edition for England, and for possible publication of some of the material in magazines, either before or after publication of the book.

I understand that you expect to begin to work on the manuscript about the first of January, and that you expect to have it completed by the end of next summer. Please let me know if there is anything I have not made clear to you, and please give me an approximate idea of when you will be able to let me have the sample material I have spoken of. There is, as I say, no hurry, but I should like to know when to expect it.

Meanwhile, I hope to have the pleasure of seeing you again before you sail, and I shall get in touch with you some time next week.
